Welcome to Lowell Elementary! We know this will be an exciting year for you and your student! In order to ensure a successful start to the school year, please review the information below.

Parent Orientation & First Day Procedures: We strongly encourage you to accompany your child on the first day of school, Thursday, August 8 and sincerely appreciate your efforts in making arrangements with your work to stay for the first 40 minutes of your child's school day in order to participate in the parent orientation. What time does my student start and end school?

School starts at 8:55. You may drop off students no earlier than 8:25. ***During the first 7 days of school (August 8-16), TK and Kindergarten students are dismissed at 12:50.*** Please remind your student where you will be picking them up [6th street is for car pickup & drop off/7th is for families who walk]

Brunch and lunch is free to all students, no application needed. Students can eat breakfast starting at 8:25 - 8:45 or during their brunch.

What school supplies do I need?

On the first day of school, August 8, as well as all subsequent days, your child should: wear the school uniform (Navy pants/shorts/skirts etc. and white or forest green polo shirt or Lowell T shirt (available for purchase in school's office), wear footwear that your child can manage independently (laces are fine if your child can tie and double knot them independently), & bring a backpack.
