Expenditure Changes - Certificated Staffing

- Multilingual Coordinator for MS 1.0 FTE
- Director of Equity (from 1X to on-going)
- MMS: Convert Dean to AP (2nd AP)
- SPED TOSA 1.0 FTE
- Community Base Teacher 1.0 FTE
- Elementary Math TOSA 1.0 FTE
- Secondary IS TOSA 1.0 FTE
- Director of Special Ed (1.0) FTE
- 8th grade Math MMS 0.2 FTE
- 4th grade teacher DVE 1.0 FTE

Expenditures Changes – Classified Staffing

- Third Campus Safety Officer from 2 High Schools: Convert from 1X to on-going
- Community Base para: 6.5 hours
- Line of sight paras: 15.0 hours
- Para for K at THE: 6.5 hours

Special Education – New Classrooms

- 2 new DLC classrooms at BLE and SELC
 - Required 2 teachers, 4 paras, 1 BFSS and startup costs
- A new classroom for self contained Preschool at SELC
- Move a blended preschool from DEE to THE
- Add another blended Preschool program at THE

Additional Big Items in 24-25 Budget

- Multilingual teacher training, other supplies & materials
- Insurance (14.1% increase)
- Curriculum Adoptions
- Other long range project budget
- Department budget increases
- Salary increases
- SEBB increases from \$1,100/month to \$1,178/month

Unknown and Challenges

<u>Unknown</u>

- Bargaining: CAPA, IUOE, Coach/Advisor Groups
- Actual Enrollment in September and later

Challenge: Labor Shortage:

- Bus Drivers
- Para Educators
- Skilled Maintenance workers (Electrician, HVAC...)
