- Arson
- Bias behavior
- Bomb threats
- Bullying/Harassment/Intimidation
- Cell phone and smartwatch misuse
- Destruction of school property
- False alarms
- Fight and/or group fighting
- Gang Activity
- Inappropriate dress
- Inappropriate use of Electronic and Communication Devices
- Inciting others to violence and disruption
- Possession or use of weapon
- Possession, use or distribution of alcohol, controlled dangerous substances, counterfeit or look-alike drugs or drug paraphernalia
- Possession, use, or distribution of tobacco, nicotine delivery devices, or vapes (smoking/vaping)
- Possession or use of laser pointers
- Sexual harassment
- Theft
- Vandalism
- Verbal/Written and/or Physical attack and/or threat
- Violating School Bus Safety rules
