## GOAL 1: BOARD DISTRICT LEVEL STUDENT OUTCOME **READING** GOAL

The percent of **3<sup>rd</sup>** grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR reading will increase from **38%** on August 2022 (TAPR) school year to **53%** by August 2027 school year.

**GOAL 3: BOARD DISTRICT LEVEL STUDENT OUTCOME COLLEGE, CAREER, & MILITARY READINESS**

The percentage of high school graduates that meet the criteria for **College, Career, & Military Readiness** on the Texas Accountability System will increase from **58%** in the graduating Class of 2022 (2022 TAPR) to **80%** in the graduating Class of 2027 (2028 TAPR).

The percentage of **8<sup>th</sup>** grade students that score meets grade level and above will increase from **11%** on August 2022 school year (TAPR) to **34%** by August 2027 school year.
