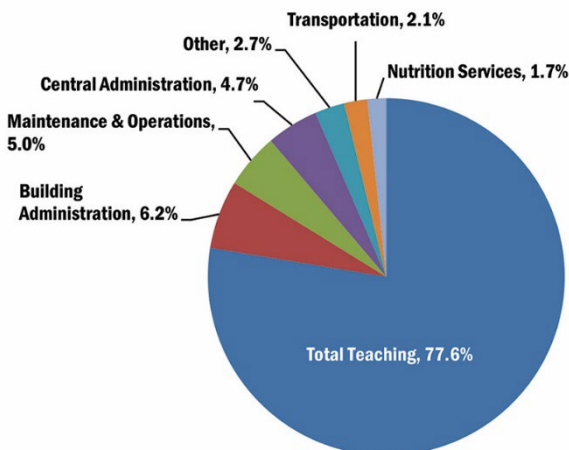
2022-23 School Goals

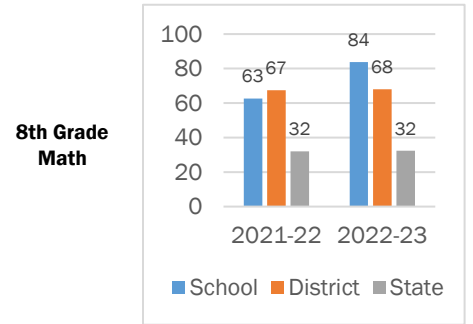
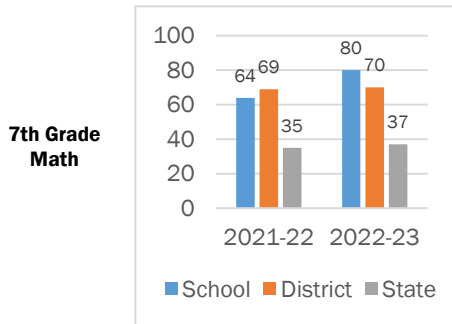
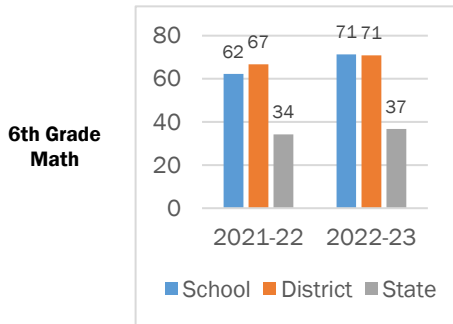
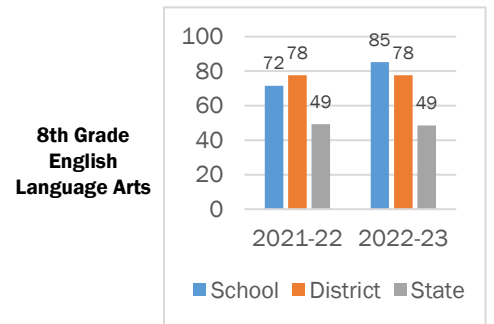
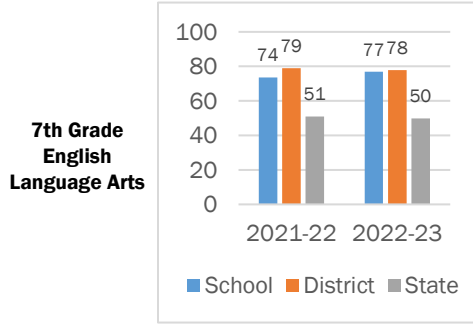
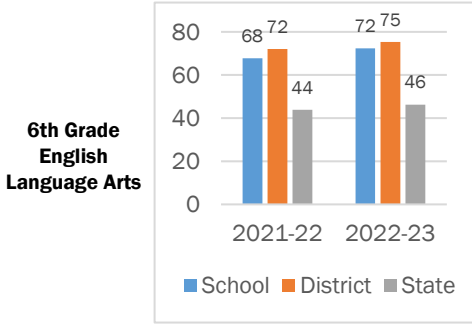
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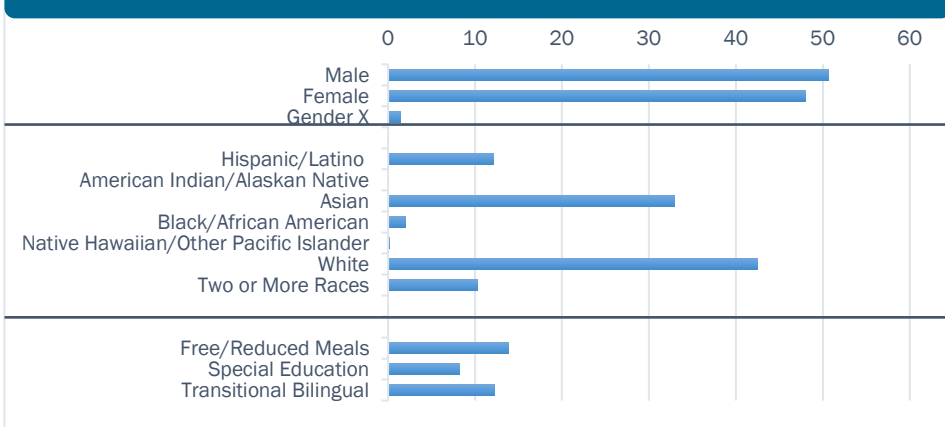
State Assessment Results
