Operation Recognition Veterans Diploma Project



Applications are now being accepted for the 15th Annual Operation Recognition Veterans Diploma Project. The initiative awards high school diplomas to eligible individuals whose high school education was interrupted due to military service or internment in a Japanese American relocation camp.

In partnership with the County of San Bernardino Department of Veterans Affairs, San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools is proud to offer this opportunity to veterans and internees who qualify for a high school diploma as authorized through the California Education Code.

Veterans who served in and received an honorable discharge from World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, or individuals who were interned in a Japanese American relocation camp are eligible to participate in this free program.

Surviving family members of those who meet these requirements are also encouraged to apply for posthumous recognition.

The applicant must be a current San Bernardino County resident and have been enrolled in high school prior to enlistment or internment.

To be considered for this year's recognition, applications must be submitted by Monday, October 2.

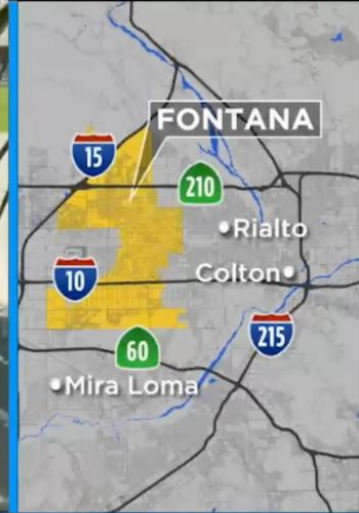
