Expanding Education from Sea to Shining Sea



SBCSS was pleased to welcome education leaders from Nan Shi Primary School for this month's Taiwan Delegation meeting.

Nan Shi Primary School officials made the nearly 7,000-mile trip to San Bernardino to discuss the Taiwan Education project, a multi-year cultural exchange between select 5th grade students from San Bernardino County and their own school sites.

Five classrooms within the County will participate in the project. Four of the participating classrooms are from the Lewis Center for Educational Research, and one classroom from Edwin Rhodes Elementary.

The Taiwan Education project is set to begin September 2023 with students becoming pen pals, writing to each other about monthly topics including celebrations observed in each country, hobbies and popular entertainment.

The Adult Drone Pilot Training Program is designed to provide students with the necessary skills to prepare for and pass the FAA Part 107 UAS Pilot Exam to become certified drone pilots.


