SBCSS recognized hundreds of graduating seniors who participated in the RIMS (Riverside, Inyo, Mono and San Bernardino Counties) AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) program. These students dedicated four to seven years to the AVID program and their commitment was rewarded.

At a ceremony that took place on May 13, more than 120 students were bestowed scholarships from several universities that included those in our local area - California State University, San Bernardino and University of California, Riverside.

Of the 27 AVID National Demonstration Schools in RIMS, 11 can be found in San Bernardino. Congratulations to the students celebrated this year for participating in AVID which is proving to transform lives through education.
