Here at American Lakes we take a positive and preventative approach to behavior through school-wide implementation of our Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) system which rewards students for adhering to our three school-wide personal standards: Show Respect, Make Good Decisions, and Solve Problems. With guidance from caring and committed staff, students will leave American Lakes as well-rounded individuals possessing social, emotional and academic skills to be successful and to continue growing as they move on to high school.

American Lakes staff work collectively to achieve NUSD's vision to provide an engaging and safe learning community where all students demonstrate responsibility, achieve academic and social-emotional growth, embrace diversity, and are prepared to make decisions about their college and career success.
