Each child is encouraged to bring one **child size (labeled with your child's name)** blanket for quiet time. If a larger blanket is provided, or more than one, you will be asked to take it home and replace it with a smaller blanket. The cubbies in the hallway do not provide enough storage space to accommodate more than one blanket or a large blanket.

Each child **MUST** bring a complete change of clothing: socks, undergarments, shirt, pants, and shoes. Please check your child's cubbies to make sure they have weather appropriate clothing and appropriate sizes. **Label all items. Please remember to return all NCECC-St. Therese clothing to the center.**

We always welcome donations of gently used clothing, which your child may have out grown to put in our extra clothes bin. Snow pants, mittens, hats, and boots are also great donations for children who may need them during the day. Always accepting plastic bags throughout the year.
