

## DRIVING DO'S

- \* Arrive on time!
- \* Enter the school by the bus entrance prior to 8:00 am.
- \* Enter through the Main Office if you arrive after 8:02 am. Bus entrance closes at 8:02 am.
- \* Exit the building through the bus entrance.
- \* Display parking tag in rear view mirror at all times.
- \* Drive the speed limit while on campus.
- \* Park in your designated spot.
- \* Watch for pedestrians while parking and/or leaving school parking lot.
- \* Watch for other moving vehicles.



## DRIVING DON'TS

- \* Don't leave school grounds without administrative approval.
- \* Don't go to your vehicle during the school day without administrative approval.
- \* Don't give your parking pass to another student to use. Passes are nontransferable.
- \* Don't park in another student's spot.
- \* Don't enter through other entrances when you arrive to school late. You must enter at the bus lot entrance (if before 8:02 am) or Main Office (after 8:02 am).

# Driving & Parking FAQ

- ◆ *Who is eligible to drive and park at school?*
  - Need to be a Junior or a Senior
  - Must have a 2.25 GPA
  - Must have photo ID
- ◆ *What do I need in order to drive to school?*
  - Completed registration form and online vehicle registration
  - Provide a copy of Driver's License, Vehicle Insurance, and Vehicle Registration
  - Provide a copy of your last quarter's report card
  - Parking Fee
  - Completed quiz
- ◆ *How much is the parking fee?*
  - \$25 fee to park for the school year
  - Cash (exact change) or Check made out to North Point High School with student name in the memo line
- ◆ *When is the parking fee due?*
  - The fee is due once the application has been processed and parking tag is picked up. Please do not submit payment when you submit the application.
- ◆ *Can I still drive and park if I have not filed an online vehicle registration and/or received a parking tag?*
  - No. You must submit the online vehicle registration and receive the parking tag prior to driving. No exceptions!
- ◆ *Where can students park?*
  - All students park in the tennis lot. Other lots are for staff & visitors.
  - Students must park in assigned space number.



## PARKING PERMIT PRIORITIES

Consideration for a parking permit will be based on the following priorities:

**Priority 1: Seniors** who are on College Waiver, Principal Waiver, or CTE/AMP Apprenticeship or Internship (with verification of approval). *(Documentation from school counselor or verification letter into the CTE/AMP apprenticeship program is required to be uploaded on the Online Vehicle Registration.)*

**Priority 2: Seniors** who are involved in extracurricular activities. *(Documentation from sponsor/coach is required to be uploaded to the Online Vehicle Registration for participation verification.)*

**Priority 3: Seniors** who work after school and must leave school to go directly to their place of employment. *(Letter required from place of employment with times you work on company letterhead.)*

**Priority 4: Juniors** who are involved in extracurricular activities. *(Documentation from sponsor/coach is required to be uploaded to the Online Vehicle Registration for participation verification.)*

**Priority 5: Juniors** who work after school and must leave to go directly to their place of employment. *(Letter required from place of employment with times you work on company letterhead.)*

**Priority 6: Seniors** without a specific need.

**Priority 7: Juniors** without a specific need.

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## Attendance and Tardy Policy

1. Arrive prior to 8 am and be in 1<sup>st</sup> block on time. 1st block begins promptly at 8:05 am.
2. If late to school, drivers must enter through the main office doors and check in at the attendance desk. The bus entrance doors are locked at 8:02 am.
3. Driving privileges may be revoked due to excessive tardies to school. *See interventions/consequences below.*
4. Students may not return to their vehicles without administrative approval until dismissal. If the student needs to obtain an item out of their vehicle, they must receive a pass to an administrator/main office for permission to go to the vehicle during the school day.
5. Students who leave early during the school day due to illness and/or an appointment should provide a parent note to the Main Office prior to 1st block. The note should state the reason for the early dismissal, the time the student needs to be dismissed, and a contact number for the parent.

5th	Warning- Parent Notification
10th	5 days- Parking Permit Revoked
15th	1 month- Parking Permit Revoked
20th	9 weeks- Parking Permit Revoked
25th	Parking Permit Revoked Indefinitely

## DRIVING AND PARKING EXPECTATIONS

Driving and parking at school is a privilege. All students who drive to school must following the Driving & Parking Policy. A student who is in violation of the driving policy may lose their parking privileges and have their vehicle towed at the owner's expense.

Students may lose their driving privileges if they:

- Are academically ineligible for a given marking period because of GPA lower than 2.25;
- Park in areas other than the spot reserved for you in the tennis court parking lot;
- Park in any other CCPS property, the Hospice Center, or Davis Rd. while in attendance during the school day;
- Drive in a dangerous or reckless manner;
- Exceed 10 MPH on campus;
- Leave school grounds during the day without prior administrative approval;
- Loiter in the parking lot;
- Allow another student to park in their spot and/or use their parking tag;
- Drive to school without their proper parking tag.
