### **Stay Cool**

### **Hydrate**

Drink plenty of fluids. Avoid sugary drinks and alcohol

Children must be dropped off and collected from their classroom doors. The front office are not responsible for taking children to class whilst the playground gates are open.

Ensuring children have a routine every at drop off and pick up helps them regulate their emotions during difficult times (coming and going from school).

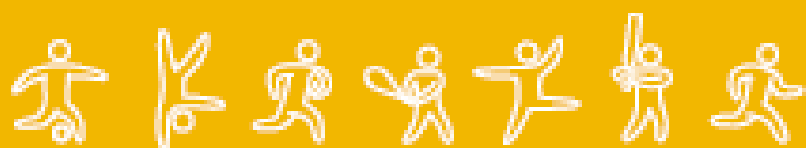
