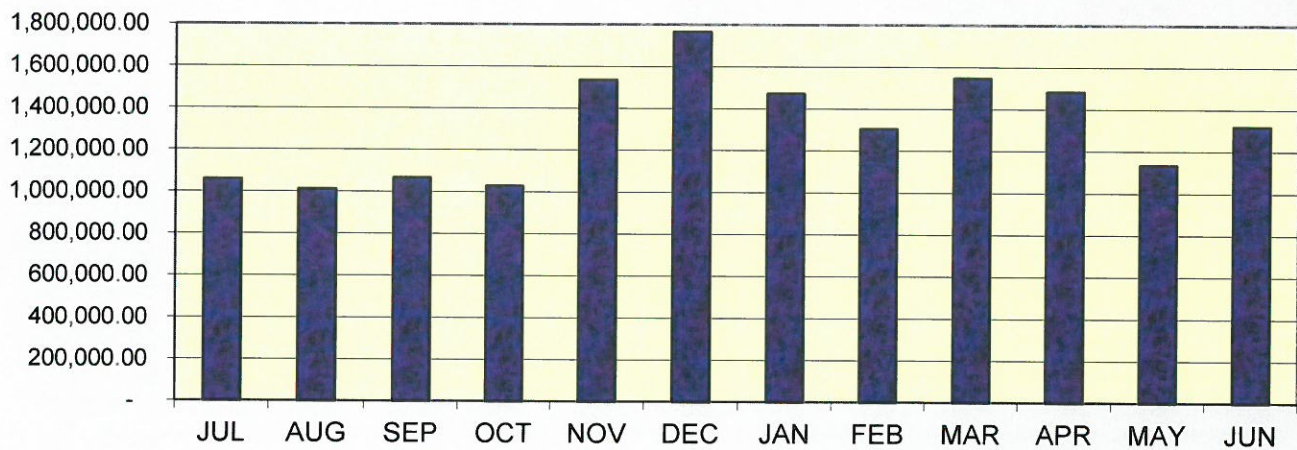
2014-15 INVESTMENTS

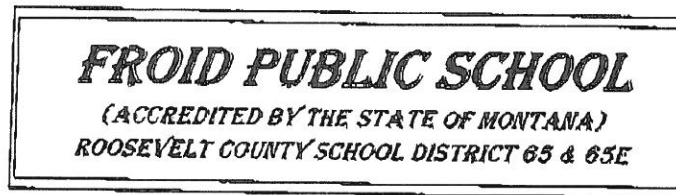
