



1-04-157. School Support Organizations.

Persons proposing to establish a school-connected organization shall submit a request to the Board for authorization to operate at the school. The request for authorization shall contain:

- 1. The name and purpose of the organization.
- 2. The date of application.
- 3. Bylaws, rules, and procedures under which the organization will operate, include procedures for maintaining the organization's finances, membership qualifications, if any, and an agreement that the group will not engage in unlawful discrimination.
- 4. The names, addresses, and phone numbers of all officers.
- 5. A list of specific objectives.
- 6. An agreement to grant the District the right to audit the group's financial records at any time, either by District personnel or a certified public accountant.
- 7. The name of the bank where the organization's account will be located and the names of those authorized to withdraw funds.
- 8. The signature of the Superintendent of the supporting school.
- 9. Planned use for any money remaining at the end of the year, if the organization is not continued or authorized to continue in the future.
- 10. An agreement to provide evidence of liability insurance as required by law.
- 11. Requests for annual reauthorization shall be presented to the Board each year in June.
- 12. Upon authorization by the Board, school-connected organizations may use the school's name, the school's team names, or any logo attributable to the school or the District.
- 13. School-connected organizations are prohibited from hiring or directly paying District employees. Organizations may make donations to the District to cover costs of additional employees, but only if such positions are approved in advance by the Board. At their discretion, employees may volunteer to perform activities for school-connected organizations during non-working hours.

Millard E. Peterson Scholarship

Rules for Award

- Name of Scholarship Award: The name of the annual scholarship awarded under the terms of the Last Will and Testament of Millard E. Peterson, deceased, shall be the "Millard E. Peterson Scholarship".
- Amount and Number of Annual Scholarship(s): The amount of each scholarship to be awarded shall be \$5000. All monies on deposit in the trust on January 1st for this scholarship will be divided by the scholarship award amount to determine the number of available scholarships for each year. determined by the following formula: all monies on deposit in the trust on January 1st shall be equally divided with a minimum of \$4000 per scholarship award.
- Eligibility of Applicants: An applicant shall be deemed qualified to apply for the award if he/she is a needy and worthy graduating senior, who has attended Culbertson Montana High School for three consecutive years including his/her senior year.

The selection committee will weigh need and worth equally. Candidates will be rank-ordered by need and rank-ordered by worth and an aggregate score determined (for example if there are seven applicants, and one applicant is ranked most needy and the forth most worthy the applicant would have an aggregate score of ten — seven points need/three points worth). The highest aggregate scores of eligible candidates will be awarded the available scholarships and the remaining candidates will be notified as alternates. In the event of a tie, the applicant with the higher rank-order by need will prevail; and should the tie still exist the committee shall determine a winner.

- Application for Scholarship Award: The selection committee named award the Millard E. Peterson Scholarship shall be; the principal of the high school, a high school teacher selected annually by the superintendent of schools, and one lay member of the community selected annually by the Mayor of the City of Culbertson. The committee shall furnish application forms to eligible applicants who request one. The application forms shall be available the first week of January. Each application shall contain a statement by the applicant agreeing to be bound by the Rules for Award of the Millard E. Peterson Scholarship and the scholarship award shall be subject to such agreement.
- Award of Scholarship: The selection committee shall, each year, on or prior to May 1st select awardees and alternates of outstanding Culbertson High School graduates based upon the applications submitted, and make arrangements for presentation of the awards. At the presentation during graduation exercises, it shall be announced that the award is being made in honor of Mr. and Mrs. Lewis Peterson by their son Millard E. Peterson, who attended Culbertson High School. The application of each winner shall be maintained in a permanent file by the selection committee. Other applications shall be retained by the

selection committee until the scholarship for that term has been fully paid.

Payment of Scholarship Award: The scholarship award shall be paid by the Fund Custodian as these rules allow:

- A. The award will be paid to the student.
- B. The award will be paid in full at the end of the first grading period (quarter or semester) if the student has maintained a 2.5 grade point average. If some form of assessment is used other than a grade point average, the institution must convert their assessment system to a grade point average.
- C. The award must be paid in full at the end of the second grading period if the student has maintained a cumulative 2.5 grade point average; however if the student has not maintained a 2.5 GPA by the end of his/her second semester the award is forfeited.
- D. The awardee must be a full-time student of an institution.

Forfeiture of Scholarship: The Millard E. Peterson Scholarship shall be payable only to defray the expenses for further education of the scholarship winner.

- A. The winner must register and attend an accredited school, vocational/technical school, college, or university within twenty-four (24) months following the award or the scholarship shall be forfeited.
- B. If the scholarship winner should register and commence attending a school, vocational/technical school, college, or university, but should later cease attending without adequate reason, or should be expelled for disciplinary reasons, or be refused further attendance because of inadequate grades, the scholarship shall be forfeited.
- C. Failure to earn a 2.5 grade point average by the end of the second grading period will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
- Deferral of Scholarship: If the scholarship winner should be prevented from registering and attending, or be forced to discontinue higher education for reasons of ill health, military service, or other reason sufficient in the judgement of the selection committee to excuse attendance, the fund custodian shall maintain the original scholarship award amount and shall pay it to the winner when he/she is able to resume attendance; provided that no deferred payments shall be held longer than six years form the time of interruption. The deferred amount will not collect interest.
- Award of Scholarship to Alternate Winners: In the event a scholarship award for any particular year is forfeited, the selection committee shall then select an alternative winner. The alternate winner, if eligible and qualified for the scholarship, shall then be entitled to the scholarship award payable upon proof of academic eligibility. If none of the other applicants should be eligible and qualified, the remaining balance shall be pooled with the next funds received from the Millard E. Peterson Charitable Unitrust.
- Fund Custodian: The Fund Custodian shall be the Culbertson School Board. The Fund Custodian shall disburse funds to scholarship winners as directed by the Rules. The Fund Custodian shall keep a record of monies in a manner consistent with generally accepted

accounting principles. The Fund Custodian shall invest uncommitted monies at its discretion for the future benefit of awardees.

Rule Adoption and Amendment: These Rules shall become effective upon approval by the Culbertson Board of Trustees, and shall remain in effect until amended by the Board. Notice of any request for amendment of Rules must be made to the Board of Trustees, at which time a hearing date will be established for considering such amendment. The foregoing Rules for Award of the Millard E. Peterson Scholarship are approved on this 15th day of March, 1990, by official Board action. Amended February 18, 1992. Amended February 18, 2002.
