GCJBT and SISC School Districts



- Early Retirees under age 65
- Employees approaching age 65
- Post 65 employees

Retired or Planning on Retirement

Three (3) months prior to age 65 or 3 months before retirement month, have the member go to their local Social Security office to enroll in Medicare Parts A&B.

Retirees wanting to enroll in Senior Advantage Group Plan under Gold Coast or SISC:

- must live in the Senior Advantage service area
- must have Medicare Parts A&B
- must complete the appropriate forms to enroll

District provides the retiree a Senior Advantage Group Enrollment Packet

Already a Kaiser Permanente member
-fill out a Senior Advantage group election form



New to Kaiser Permanente
- fill out a CA Group Application form
- fill out Senior Advantage group election form

Retiree returns the forms to School District.

District sends it over to appropriate carrier.

Carriers sends the eligibility to KP and KPSA group election forms are faxed to:

NOTE: Effective dates for KPSA is the 1st of the month following KP's receipt of the form, unless member requested a future date. Enrollments cannot be retro-back unless the group date-stamped the form the previous month before requested date.
