
### Oxnard School District **Lockdown Communication Flow Chart**

#### Oxnard School District Lockdown Protocol Chart

# PRIORITY 1 – IMMEDIATE THREAT OR DANGER

- Initiate lockdown with schoolwide announcement "This is a priority one lockdown. Secure all doors immediately."
- 2. Direct students indoors to closest secure area.
- 3. Lock and secure doors.
- 4. Cover windows.
- 5. Turn off lights.
- 6. Mute all cell phones and remain quiet.
- 7. Wait for additional instructions.
- 8. Construct barriers (furniture, desks, etc).
- 9. Stay as far from windows as possible.
- 10. Instruct students to lie down and take cover behind the barriers.
- 11. Plan for personal care (restroom) within the classroom.
- 12. Calm and reassure students.
- 13. Take attendance.
- 14. Do not open the classroom doors unless directed by law enforcement.
- 15. Remember "RUN, HIDE, FIGHT" for active shooter situations.

# PRIORITY 2 – NO IMMEDIATE THREAT OR DANGER

- Initiate lockdown with schoolwide announcement "This is a priority two lockdown. Secure all doors."
- 2. Direct students indoors to their classroom or closest secure area.
- 3. Lock and secure doors.
- 4. Cover windows.
- 5. Wait for additional instructions.
- 6. Plan for personal care (restroom) within the classroom.\*
- 7. Calm and reassure students.
- 8. Take attendance.
- 9. Do not open the classroom doors unless directed by law enforcement.

\*Students may leave the classroom to use the restroom <u>only with escort from</u> law enforcement or administrator.

Classroom instruction may continue during a priority two lockdown, but staff should remain vigilant in case the event becomes a priority one lockdown.

#### **ENDING A LOCKDOWN**

- 1. A lockdown DRILL or a PRIORITY TWO lockdown may be ended by an announcement from site administrator of "All CLEAR".
- 2. A PRIORITY ONE lockdown may be ended only by law enforcement or administrator opening the door and clearing the area.
