

This is one of our capstone programs here at GSL, and as such, it's a large one to manage. It's with the support and effort of many people behind the scenes that we launch our 8th graders into the working world each year. Many teachers, faculty, and staff (both past and present!) have offered contacts or actually offered to mentor our students. They all deserve a pat on the back.

One more stat that I consistently find interesting: Each year - when I think we have pretty much exhausted the Memphis-area business world - our students come up with new businesses to contact. You'd think that after 16 years or so, we'd run out of new places. Not true! This year **nine** new businesses have offered to mentor our students! Notable new supporters include the President and CEO of MLGW - Doug McGowen, Bruce McMullen - a managing shareholder at Baker Donelson, and professional soccer player Caleb Patterson-Sewell, who is now a coach for 901FC.

The connections that GSL students have made with some movers and shakers in this city is undeniable... and as far as we know, there isn't another school in the city that gives 8th graders this opportunity.


