Things to Know about Grandparents' Day

Chapel will take place at Grace-St. Luke's Episcopal Church, 1720 Peabody Avenue, Memphis, TN 38104.

Parking is available in the lot across from the church (southeast corner of Belvedere and Peabody), behind the Anchor Center, and on Belvedere, Peabody, and Lemaster.

Grandparents/Special Friends: If you are bringing your grandchildren to school, please go directly to the church with your grandchildren. There is no assigned seating, so please sit where you prefer.

Grandparents/Special Friends who are meeting their grandchildren at GSL should go directly to the church. The children will join you in the church prior to the start of Chapel.

Bottled water and muffins will be available between Chapel and classroom visits.

After the classroom visits, children may leave campus for the day with their grandparents/special friends. Students who stay at school will be picked up in carpool at 12 p.m. ACE: After School Care is open until 5:30 p.m.

Grandparents' Day

Tuesday, November 22

We are excited for Grandparents' Day tomorrow! Here are some important reminders:

Lower & Middle School Students

Grandparents' Day will begin with Chapel at Grace-St. Luke's Church at 8:15 a.m. for Lower & Middle School students (grades SK-8). Students can arrive at school at their normal time (between 7-8 a.m.), or they can arrive between 8-8:15 a.m. in time for Chapel.

If students come to school with their grandparents/special friends, they should go directly to the church.

If they are dropped off at school, they should go to their classrooms. They will walk to the church with their class in time for Chapel. Students will locate and sit with their grandparents/special friends in the church.

After Chapel, students will escort their grandparents/special friends to their classrooms. After the classroom visit, students are free to leave for the day with their grandparents/special friends. Students who do not leave with their guests will stay at school until dismissal at 12 p.m. (As a reminder, ACE: After School Care is open from 12-5:30 p.m. Students who attend after care should bring a lunch and snack.)

Students who are not staying for after care are encouraged to leave all backpacks and other school supplies at home on Grandparents' Day.

Preschool Students

Grandparents' Day will begin with Chapel at Grace-St. Luke's Church at 9:30 a.m. for Preschool students (grades LL-JK). Students can arrive at school at their normal time (between 7-8 a.m.), or they can arrive between 8-9:30 a.m. in time for Chapel.

If Preschool students come to school with their grandparents/special friends later in the morning for Chapel at 9:30 a.m., they should go directly to the church. If they are dropped off at school, they should go to their classrooms. They will walk to the church with their class in time for Chapel. Students will locate and sit with their grandparents/special friends in the church.

After Chapel, students will escort their grandparents/special friends to their classrooms. After the classroom visit, students are free to leave for the day with their grandparents/special friends. Students who do not leave with their guests will stay at school until dismissal at 12 p.m. (As a reminder, ACE: After School Care is open from 12-5:30 p.m. Students who attend after care should bring a lunch and snack.)

Preschool students who are not staying for after care are encouraged to leave all backpacks and other school supplies at home on Grandparents' Day.




Water Fountains Temporarily Closed, Bring Refillable Bottles


