

The front office will be closed during Honors Chapel and Graduation to allow all administrative staff to attend the special ceremonies.


Honors Chapel is this Friday, May 20, at 1:45 p.m. The front office will be closed on May 20 from 1:30-3 p.m.

Graduation is next Wednesday, May 25, at 10:30 a.m. The front office will be closed on May 25 from 10 a.m. - 12 p.m.


Please note: If your child needs early dismissal on either day, be sure and schedule your pickup for a time when the front office is open.


