SAFE RETURN TO IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION

The district still encourages hand washing and the "appropriate" use of hand sanitizer. There is signage in our schools that reminds all personnel and students about hand washing. Hand sanitizer stations are still located throughout all of the buildings on our campus. Our custodial staff replaces the sanitizer and soap in all areas on a daily basis.

4) Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities, including improving ventilation

Our ventilation system is set in each room to circulate outside air. Our custodians clean each building daily and high traffic areas such as the cafeterias and all purpose rooms are cleaned frequently throughout the school day.
