Executive Summary

The September McClymonds PAC meeting is the first meeting to occur since the start of the new school year. As a result, there was some review of the prior information presented in the previous PAC meetings, as new participants were brought up to date.

PAC Questions and Answers

Will parents/teachers be included in the design phase?

Absolutely. We have defined a schedule and will present at the end of the presentation.

Also during the last phone bank, we sent a follow up text message. Parents liked receiving text messages in communication. We are working on more parent involvement and engagement in the upcoming tour.

What constitutes the 9/5/23 Budget update?

As we go through the design process, design details become clearer. Through this process, we can begin to narrow down priorities and take a good look at options and other things.

Seismic costs are a factor. The Tier 2 Seismic Report has been completed since the last meeting. Now that we have the Tier 2 report, there are 1-3 priorities.

Is there a budget for new furniture and equipment?

There is a budget for furniture and equipment which is outside of the construction project budget.

When room layouts are finalized, there will be a RFP put out for companies to bid on furniture and equipment.

How does the slow passage of time/actions influence the budget?

It can influence the budget up or down as we consider the times we are in. Everyone knows about escalation and how it could impact prices. Naturally, the budget will not be changed, but how far that money goes will change based on the costs at the time of the work.

In Measure B, were we passed over?

That prior measure money is gone. There might be District projects in process from a previous measure, but those allocated funds could not be used to support the current project.

What will be the concession stands design?

We haven't gotten specific layouts yet, but we are in consensus that a concession stand is needed.

What will happen for storage for teachers? Will there be cabinetry?

Yes and we will talk to teachers and get feedback on what they want for storage.
