



# D.O.U.D.:

## Dress out of uniform Day (dress down day)

<b>DRESS OUT OF UNIFORM</b>
T-Shirts/Sweatshirts/Tops: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Appropriate / Modest</li> <li>Length <b>MUST</b> cover the student's body when standing and sitting</li> <li>No cutoff, midriff, or low-cut</li> </ul>
T-Shirts/Sweatshirts/Tops: <b>NOT ALLOWED</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tight, revealing, low neckline</li> <li>Rock band, vulgar, alcohol or drug, violence references, or objectionable references</li> <li>No sleeveless, cap sleeves, midriff, or low-cut</li> </ul>
Skirts/Dresses <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Length - no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the knee</li> <li>Not tight or revealing</li> <li>NO sleeveless or cap sleeves</li> </ul>
Leggings or Jeggings: <b>*Girls in 5th - 8th</b> must have an appropriate length top that covers at least 2 inches above the knee to mid-thigh
STS Spirit Wear Sweatpants only!
Capri's (August - October 31 & April 1 - June)
Jeans – no holes, rips, tears, frayed, sagging
Athletic Pants (mesh or "windbreakers")
Cargo Shorts (August - October 31 & April 1 - June) or Uniform Shorts or PE Shorts or Shorts for girls that are above the knee to mid-thigh (about 2 or 3 inches above the knee)
Other shoes & Sneakers: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Toes &amp; Heals <b>MUST</b> be covered</li> <li><b>No</b> flip-flops, open-toed sandals, crocs, Hey Dudes</li> </ul>
White, black, or blue LOGO socks are allowed
Dress Code under OTHER & HAIR still apply

### **Dress-Up Days**

- Boys – dress shirts, tie, and dress pants with dress shoes. Boot-type footwear is **NOT** permitted.
- Girls – no skirts or dresses that are too tight and/or too short (no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the knee); no sleeveless, cap sleeves, midriff, or low-cut tops.

# UNACCEPTABLE APPAREL ITEMS

## Subject to Disciplinary Action

### Female Students

**Shoes: Do Not Wear**

- Canvas shoes (HEY DUDE), sandals, flip flops, clogs, slippers
- Sneakers on a regular uniform day (gym days only)
- Patterned shoes

**Socks: Do Not Wear**

- (middle school) - Leggings
- (all girls) - LOGO socks with a uniform- (gym days only)

**Uniform: Do Not**

- Roll your skirt so that it is shorter than 2 inches above your knee
- Wear any alternate sports team attire (local or travel team, CYO, etc.) unless prior permission is provided
- Wear logo shorts or sweatpants, sweatshirts, shirts (Nike, Adidas, Under Armor, etc.) on gym days (uniform shorts only)

**Other: Do Not**

- Wear multiple earrings
- Oversized earrings (no cartilage earrings, large studs, hoops, or drop earrings)
- Wear multiple necklaces, or oversized necklace chains, or add decorative elements to chains
- Wear shell, beaded jewelry, chokers
- Wear bracelets
- Wear large rings or multiple rings
- Wear large decorations in hair or large headbands
- No facial / body piercings of any kind (nose, eyebrow, lip, tongue, belly button, etc.)
- Tattoos are not allowed anywhere on the body
- Wear any colored nail polish of any type or fake/ extended nails
- Wear colored extensions or alternate hair coloring (EX: no pink, green, purple, orange, blue, etc....) hair that is half one color and half another color
- No perfumes, cologne, body spray

# UNACCEPTABLE APPAREL ITEMS

Subject to Disciplinary Action

<b>Male Students</b>
<b>Shoes: Do Not Wear</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Canvas shoes (HEY DUDE), sandals, flip flops, clogs, slippers</li><li>• Sneakers on a regular uniform day (gym days only)</li><li>• Patterned shoes</li></ul>
<b>Socks: Do Not Wear</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• LOGO socks with a uniform- (gym days only)</li></ul>
<b>Uniform: Do Not</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Wear any alternate sports team attire (local or travel team, CYO, etc.) unless prior permission is provided</li><li>• Wear logo shorts or sweatpants, sweatshirts, shirts (Nike, Adidas, Under Armor, etc.) on gym days (uniform approved only)</li></ul>
<b>Other: Do Not</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Wear any type of earrings</li><li>• Wear multiple necklaces, or oversized necklace chains, or add decorative elements to chains</li><li>• Wear shell, beaded jewelry, chokers</li><li>• Wear bracelets</li><li>• Wear large rings or multiple rings</li><li>• No facial / body piercings of any kind (nose, eyebrow, lip, tongue, belly button, etc.)</li><li>• Tattoos are not allowed anywhere on the body</li><li>• Wear any colored nail polish of any type or fake/ extended nails</li><li>• Wear colored extensions or alternate hair coloring (EX: no pink, green, purple, orange, blue, etc....) hair that is half one color and half another color</li><li>• No perfumes, cologne, body spray</li><li>• No facial hair (beard, mustache, sideburns)</li></ul>

There will always exist occasions when a student's manner of dress or appearance is subject to administrative disapproval, despite endless criteria being established. We, therefore, expect parents and students to willingly accept the administration's ruling on a student's manner of dress.
