The street, Wayne Drive, in Wilbur Park was named after alumni, Wayne Kull, Class of 1951.

The first four footed security system at night in the Bayless Elementary School was a German Shepherd name Gretchen. She belonged to Superintendent, Hugo E. Beck. Gretchen roamed the halls in the building. In the morning, before he went to his 5th grade class in the Intermediate Building, Chris Petty (Class of 1968) would come in to cleanup. Gretchen was taken in by the Petty family when the Becks moved. Gretchen passed away and was buried in their backyard.

Students who lived across Gravois Road went to Little Bayless on Heege Road until 5th grade when they transferred to the two story school on Weber Road, building now demolished.

The school colors in the elementary, grades K-8, were blue & gold and senior high, grades 9-12, were green & gold.

Smoking was permitted behind the high school building which is now the junior high.

Another name for the Dramatics Club was The Footlighters.

The GAA, Girls Athletic Association, was called the WAA, Women's Athletic Association.

The pretzel man who sold pretzels during lunch time in front of the two story elementary building which was demolished.

Graduation, weather permitting, was held in back of the high school, now the junior high school.



The flooding on Mother's Day (May 14) hit Bayless High School particularly hard. The high school cafeteria, gymnasium, and several rooms were flooded and required remediation. Much of the flooring needed replacement as a result.

Bayless Field was damaged significantly. The force and quantity of water flooding onto the field stretched the turf seams and shifted the rock base under the field. This created signifcant uneveness and unsafe conditions for sports.


