Task 1:

Read and annotate: Pride and Prejudice and Zombies by Seth Grahame-Smith

Task 2:

In MLA format and in response to Grahame-Smith's novel, write a 4-5 paragraph essay examining the dichotomy of the formality of time period and the apocalyptic tension. Do not use an AI chatbot to write this paper.

Writing Advice:

- A proper introduction with a thematic statement and thesis statement, titles, authors
- At least 2 body paragraphs (with clear and strong topic sentences + details from the literature to support that prove each paragraph's topic sentence and the thesis of your essay)
- A conclusion that does not simply repeat the introduction but rather provides a more compelling and convincing closing

Remember the 3Ts: third person language (so avoid using "you" and "I"), present tense, and serious tone.

Briefly PLAN your essay before writing and PROOFREAD it afterward.

Annotation Advice:

There are many ways to interact with a text. Consider asking a lot of questions, defining words you don't know, making personal connections, and commenting on language that you find beautiful, challenging, or confusing. Find a way to balance your annotations with your enjoyment of the reading.
