If you are currently enrolled in an accredited State Department of Public Education "Online Program" you are not required to file an "Intent to provide Home Education" because your online program qualifies as an authorized educational program.

Statutory definition (SB 07-215): "On-line program" means a full-time on-line education program or school that delivers a sequential program of synchronous or asynchronous instruction from a teacher to a student primarily through the use of technology via the internet in a virtual or remote setting."
