

Types of Support

Special Education classrooms typically have at least one teacher and a Special Education Assistant to help support students and their learning throughout the day. This provides more one-on-one time to focus on lessons and areas of growth!



Emotional Support

Emotional Support programs are for students whose behavior interferes with their ability to learn and progress within the general education curriculum in the regular education setting. Students participate in this program to varying degrees depending upon their level of need for social, emotional, and behavioral support. Itinerant, supplemental, and full-time time programs are available to students K-12. Intensive services for students in need of a greater degree of support is provided in Grandview Elementary, Belle Valley Elementary, Tracy Elementary, Westlake Middle School, J.S. Wilson Middle School, Walnut Creek Middle School, McDowell Intermediate High School, and McDowell High School. MTSD also provides the educational component for students in the Sarah A. Reed Children's' Center (SARCC) residential treatment facility located within district boundaries.
