IMPORTANT TRANSFER INFORMATION:

- ✓ Transfer: If you decide to have your student return to in person learning this year, they will return to their home school if there is space.
 - Transfers for Middle & High School Students will be at the end or beginning of each semester.
 - If there is no longer any space in your student's home school, they will be transferred to another school in the district where there is space.
 - Intra-District Transfers must be approved by Student Services. The time window is 10/15 – 1/15 (the year prior).


Independent Study (CDE): is available to pupils from kindergarten through high school and is designed to respond to the pupil's unique educational needs, interests, aptitudes, and abilities within the confines of legal authority and school board policy. Pupils who participate in independent study have the same course requirements as pupils in a regular course of study at site-based schools.

Independent Study is not Distance Learning!

STEPS TO STARTING SCHOOL

- Families must complete Orientation
- Master Agreement: Students and families will sign their Master Agreement during Orientation
- Complete Data Confirmation for Tracy Charter after Orientation
- Any other required documents for enrollment
- NEW STUDENTS: Select Courses (for 6th-12th only)





STARTING SCHOOL

- Start Times for Students:
 - 8:00 AM for Elementary
 - 8:30 AM for Middle & High School
- The assigned teacher will send a Welcome Email on **Friday** prior to the first day of school. Students will need to check their TUSD student email account for this information.
- All school communications will be sent to the TUSD student email account.



WHAT DO STUDENTS NEED TO START SCHOOL?

Students need the following materials to start their school year:

- <u>Technology</u>: TUSD computer and hotspot prior to the first day of school. The Office Staff will contact the family once it is ready for pick-up.
- Grade Level Workbooks: Elementary (K-5) Students will be notified when workbooks are ready for pick-up.



<u>Weekly Meetings</u>: The assigned teacher will reach out to the student and family to schedule their weekly <u>in-person</u> meeting time.

This is a **MANDATORY** requirement to participate in the Tracy Charter School program.

- Missed Weekly Meetings due to emergencies must be rescheduled and completed
- After missing 3 Weekly Meetings the Administration will follow up with parent
- If missed meetings continue to be an issue, the student may be returned to their home school
- Camera on during Microsoft Teams/Video meetings



Required Group Meetings

Daily GROUP Meetings for Grades K-8th:

The assigned teacher will notify students when these meetings will occur. The teacher will check-in with students and families (for K-5) for upcoming lessons and progress.

Weekly GROUP Meetings for High School:

The assigned teacher will notify students when these meeting will occur. The purpose of this meeting is to go over weekly expectations and general class lessons.

<u>Special Education & English Leaners</u> will have additional required meetings during the week. ELD courses will be assigned to students, per their ELPAC testing level. These meetings will be scheduled by their RSP or ELD teacher.



Testing

Tracy Charter School administers mandatory student assessments as provided by the State Board of Education and the Tracy Unified School District. These assessments include, but are not limited to:

- FastBridge (Local Assessment)
 (ALL Grades)
- California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) (3rd - 8th, & 11th Grade)
- The English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC)
- Physical Fitness Test (PFT)
 (5th/7th/9th)

These assessments are required and will be administered IN-PERSON



ATTENDANCE AT THE CHARTER

Independent Study Attendance Procedures are used for Tracy Charter. There are 3 ways to receive credit for a day of attendance:

- 1. Attend the weekly 1-on-1 **in-person** meeting with the assigned teacher.
- 2. Attend a group meeting with the assigned teacher/counselor.
- 3. Log on to Edgenuity platform for a minimum of 30 minutes per day and complete one assignment during that time.

No Sick Days or Family Days





IN-PERSON WAIVER

For **returning students**, we are offering a waiver request option for those who meet certain criteria. To qualify for a waiver, students must have a 2.0 GPA or higher, with no Fs in their previous semester, and have 90% meeting attendance with teachers. Additionally, they must be staying on track with their course progress in their assigned classes.






PROGRAMS IN CLEVER

ELEMENTARY INFORMATION



Participation in this program for elementary students requires the student be instructed by an adult (Learning Coach) during instructional time. The Learning Coach will be the individual that will teach the daily lessons and assignments to the student.

The Learning Coach is <u>NOT</u> the assigned teacher at Tracy Charter!

Daily instruction with teacher includes: the following.....

- Math
- English Language ArtsScience
- Social Studies





Elementary Students Time on Task:

Students are expected to work on the Genius K-5 platform for approximately 4 hours daily (Monday -Friday). If there is a situation that a student is unable to work the necessary hours during a normal school day, then at a minimum the student should be completing at least 30 minutes and finishing one assignment during the day.

Classes:

- Students will be registered for a minimum of 6 classes per semester.
- Student courses will be offered using the Edgenuity platform.


