

Greeley-Evans School District 6 HB21-1110 & HB24-1454 First Quarterly Progress-to-Date Report (July 1, 2024 - September 30, 2024)

Greeley-Evans School District 6 is committed to inclusion, equity, and access to its programs, services, and activities for all individuals. This includes ensuring that every person has equal access to Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in active use procured, developed, maintained or used by the district. The district is committed to a timely response to reports of inaccessible ICT or requests for reasonable accommodations or modifications.

In accordance with the ADA, C.R.S. §§ 24-85-101 et seq., and as established by the Office of Information Technology's Technology Accessibility Rules, [8 CCR 1501-11](#), the district is actively working towards being aligned with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) version 2.1, level AA criteria to provide equal access to information and communication technology for people with disabilities, or make reasonable accommodations or modifications if needed..

Pursuant to HB24-1454, the following First Quarterly Progress-to-Date Report demonstrates concrete and specific efforts toward compliance with Colorado's accessibility requirements.

Website Compliance Plan

1. Greeley-Evans School District 6 has contracted with a new vendor, Finalsite, to create a website that is accessible and has accessibility alert and redress features in the event of inaccessible content.
2. FinalSite contains embedded features that alert staff to inaccessible content and demonstrate how to make the content accessible.
3. Greeley-Evans School District 6 utilizes AudioEye via Finalsite to scan the website and provide accessibility feedback for remediation.
4. Greeley-Evans School District 6 will promptly fix all issues reported by AudioEye.
5. Greeley-Evans School District 6 to provide transcript on the website of any PDF posted on the website to ensure compliance
6. Greeley-Evans School District 6 has included an [Accessibility Statement on its website](#) to allow users to report any accessibility issues to Greeley-Evans School District 6 and to request accommodations.

Staff Training

1. Greeley-Evans School District 6 has provided in-depth training to its district leadership team and content managers on creating and maintaining accessible web content.
2. Greeley-Evans School District 6 will continue to provide in-depth training to building and department Accessibility Champions to train their staff on accessibility and be a resource for accessibility questions and issues.
3. Greeley-Evans School District 6 to require current and new staff who create content or manage platforms to complete an annual Accessibility training.

Application Compliance

1. Greeley-Evans School District 6 to use Learn Platform for all application requests.
2. Greeley-Evans School District 6 to send a vendor HB21-1110 Accessibility form to all current vendors and to all new vendors prior to contract/use approval.
3. Vendors to be in compliance with HB21-1110, or Greeley-Evans School District 6 to complete [Undue Burden, Fundamental Alteration, or Direct Threat/EEAAP](#).

Documents and other Digital Resource Compliance

1. Greeley-Evans School District 6 has put out requests for production to contract with a vendor for assessment and remediation of documents.
2. Greeley-Evans School District 6 to use Adobe Accessibility checker for all Adobe created documents and graphics and to save Accessibility reports.
3. Greeley-Evans School District 6 contracted with Equidox PDF software as an additional remediation and compliance tool.

Ongoing Support and Oversight

1. Accessibility Team to consist of Information Technology, Communications, and Legal.
2. Greeley-Evans School District 6 has put out requests for production to contract with a vendor to partner on a full web and technology accessibility audit, including remediation strategies, implementation supports, and for testing and continued monitoring.
