Goal I: To increase the levels of achievement for all students

- To increase levels of achievement in reading, writing, and math as defined by state and district assessments.
- To increase the graduation rate annually.
- To increase alignment of curriculum, assessment, and instruction to the academic content standards for language arts, reading, writing, mathematics, art, civics, economics, world languages, geography, history, music, physical education, and science.
- To increase the number of children participating in quality early childhood education programs.

Goal II: To increase accountability at all levels

- To increase accuracy and timeliness of district reports and other assessment.
- To annually increase the number of administrators exceeding performance standards based on improving student achievement.
- To annually increase the use of data to guide professional development and to improve teacher effectiveness as measured by improvements or increased student achievement.
- To annually decrease the number of staff members performing below standard on evaluation measures by 100 %.

Goal III: To increase the District's overall efficiency and effectiveness

- To annually increase the efficiency level of support services by 5% as measured by data collected each year and compared to industry standards and best practices.
- To increase the number of quality staff hired each year as measured through the performance evaluation process and other measures.
- To increase staff efficiency through the effective use of technological services, equipment, software, training, and personnel to support instruction, data analysis, and reporting.

Goal IV: To increase the level of effective communication and collaboration with internal and external stakeholders

- To increase the consistency of internal communication.
- To increase the quality of communication with the community.
- To annually increase and maintain at 100% the number of sites with appropriate parent and community representation on site-based and accountability committees.
- To increase the participation of parents and community members in school and related activities.
- To increase parent attendance at parent/teacher conferences to 100%.
- To increase community support for upgrading physical facilities and enhancing the instructional program.

Goal V: To increase the quality of the teaching learning and working environment

- To increase safety and security levels in all teaching, learning, and working environments.
- To immediately decrease the number of student disciplinary infractions that compromise a safe school environment.
- To annually increase the number of schools meeting all district safety standards.

- To maintain safe and efficient buildings that meet the needs of changing educational environments and regulatory requirements.
- To increase the awareness of a respectful school climate among staff, students, and community.

Indemnification (D. 60 August 2001)

- (a) The Community Organization shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the District from any claims, losses, damages, liabilities, costs, expenses or obligations, including but not limited to attorney's fees, court costs, and punitive or similar damages, arising out of or resulting from any act or omission by Community Organization or any of its employees, agents or representatives in the furnishing of services, equipment or supplies, or arising out of or resulting from negligent, fraudulent, dishonest or other acts or omissions of Community Organization or its employees, agents or representatives in its performance under the terms of this Agreement. Community Organization agrees to provide proof of liability insurance coverage at the time of signing in a reasonable amount as required by the District.
