# Information: G. Municipal Finance Oversight Board

Dr. Magalhaes informed the Committee that a hearing was held on December 13 determining that B-P is entitled to issue qualified bonds and/or notes in the amount of \$179,997,673 for the new school.

# Information: H. Universal Design for Learning

Mrs. Guenette presented a video from Dr. Katie Novak regarding Universal Design for Learning (UDL) that was shared with staff at the beginning of the school year. She also discussed multi-tiered systems of support, social emotional learning, key levers for deeper learning, timeline of where they are now for full UDL implementation, observation statistics, early implementation expectations, additional lesson plan expectations, example strategies, and resources.

Questions were asked and answered regarding feedback from teachers, is this learning mandatory for everyone, percentage of teachers involved, data, and support for specialized students in shops.
