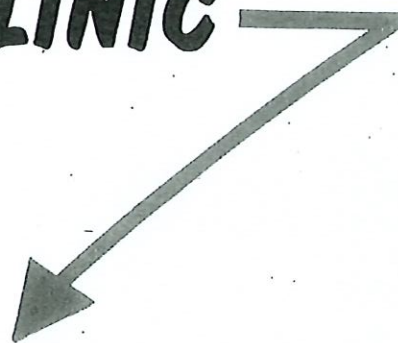

Measles Information & Tips

WHAT IS MEASLES?



Measles is a serious virus and one of the most **highly contagious and deadly** infectious diseases in human history.

SYMPTOMS AND TIMELINE:



COUGH



RUNNY NOSE

USUALLY STARTS 3 TO 5 DAYS AFTER THE OTHER SYMPTOMS.



Measles may appear differently on darker skin tones.

Measles can spread 4 days before the rash starts through 4 days after.

HOW IT SPREADS:

You can get sick by breathing air with the measles virus in it.



Measles can stay in the air and infect others for **up to 2 hours** after a contagious person has left a room.

WHAT ELSE SHOULD I KNOW?

The measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccine is safe and effective at protecting against these viruses.

If you believe you are ill with measles, and need to seek care, **CALL** the medical facility **BEFORE** arriving.

Contact your health care provider to check

IF UNVACCINATED:

- The MMR vaccine may help prevent sickness if given within three days from when you were exposed.
- If exposed, you may need to quarantine for 21 days.

Talk to your health care provider to see what options are available for you.

Pi π Day

Estell Manor School Green Team Fundraiser

Historians believe that a number close to Pi was first used to figure the circumference of a circle around 4,000 years ago by the Babylonians. Around 200 BC the Greek mathematician Archimedes continued to work on getting a more accurate number for Pi. In the 1600s, mathematicians such as Isaac Newton used math called infinite series to get even more accurate numbers. The Greek letter π was first used as the symbol for the number by Swiss mathematician

Leonhard Euler. The first organized Pi Day was in 1988 at the San Francisco Exploratorium.

Physicist Larry Shaw had the idea to celebrate the day by marching around a circle and then eating some pies.

In 2009 the US government recognized the day as National Pi Day (Ducksters, 2018).

Want to "Pi" a teacher?

March 14th would be the perfect day!

Many teachers and staff members have volunteered to support the efforts of science, math, and horticulture. The Green team will be providing whipped cream pies for a donation of \$5 dollars to students that would like to pie their teacher. Pies must be preordered by March 12th.
