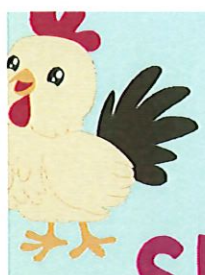

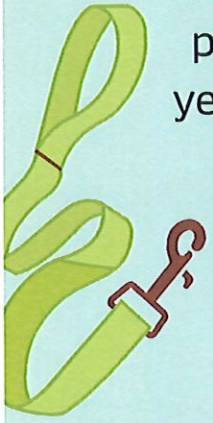

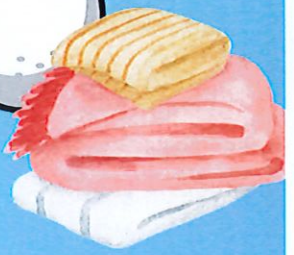


EMS Student Council's Service is collecting goods to help SJRAS in Vineland
