

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF NEEDS ASSESSMENT DATA FINDING

2021-2022

Student Achievement Conclusions

- Woodruff High School's percentage of students passing the End of Course exams was higher than that State results in three of the four content areas: Algebra I, Biology I, US History. Woodruff High School's English II percentage passing was 82.96% just below the state average of 83.47%. 2020-2021 was the first administration of the English II EOC exam.
- Woodruff High School's graduation rate is down from 85.6% (2020) to 83.2% (2021).
- The Disabled population is the only subgroup below 80%, however it has increased from 54.2% (2020) to 63% (2021).
- Woodruff High School's composite SAT score was higher than the state composite SAT score. The SAT score results in reading and writing and math exceeded the state scores as well.
- Woodruff High School's percentage of students who are College and Career Ready (71.7%) is above the state's percentage of students who are College and Career Ready (61.1%). Woodruff High School's percentage of students who are College and Career Ready cannot be compared to previous years because the cohort of students measured has changed from graduates to all students in the four year on-time graduation cohort (graduates and non-graduates).

Teacher/Administration Quality Conclusions

- In a new teacher survey, 80% of teachers new within five years to Woodruff High School reported they were fully trained on procedures, policies and philosophy.

School Climate Conclusions

- There is correlation between school climate and graduation rate. Woodruff High School continues to reestablish the school culture that existed before the school closures of 2019-2020. The graduation rate has declined in all student demographics except the English Learner and Disabled populations.
