## Opportunity

Students at South Valley Academy are provided with constant opportunities to set goals, self-assess, adjust priorities, and develop their strengths. ## Personalize

Students can personalize their education through study in online classes, standards-based assignments, Project-Based and Proficiency Based Learning, Internships with local businesses, and flexible schedules.



## Support

Students receive weekly progress reports that track the volume of work completed for the week as well as throughout the school year. Students and parents see exactly where they are in the pursuit of high school or grade level completion on a weekly basis.
