Vote NO on Amendment 4

Florida Bishops statement opposing extreme abortion amendment

Florida Amendment 4, which will appear on Florida's November 2024 ballot, is an extreme proposal that legalizes full-term abortion with no protections for the preborn child, including when the child is capable of feeling pain. This proposed amendment to our state constitution would prohibit all restrictions on abortion before viability and create a broad exception that any healthcare provider could exploit to allow abortion up to birth.

Our call to ACTION as Catholics

Archbishop Thomas Wenski tells us that, "As Catholics we believe that human life is sacred, and that the dignity of the human person is the foundation of a moral vision of society." Human beings, including unborn children are all created in God's image and likeness and therefore matter. We are called to take civic action by using our vote to counter this dangerous injustice against the most innocent among us--the unborn child, and to also protect women from the harms of abortion. We have a moral obligation to protect human life by voting NO on Amendment 4 in this November's ballot. And we must never forget that **EVERY LIFE MATTERS.**


Reflections From Our Pastor






