

## Student Achievement Awards 2024/25

### Terms and conditions

1. COBIS member schools and Applicant schools can nominate students for a Student Achievement Award. Each school with a registered COBIS account should participate as an individual school.
2. Each school may nominate up to three students to receive a Student Achievement Award.
3. Nominations must be submitted online via the form on the COBIS website by a member of staff.
4. Nominations must be received before the deadline of 3pm GMT on Wednesday 2 April 2025 to be accepted.
5. All nominations must include a reason for the nomination.
6. Nominated students must be in Key Stage 2, 3, 4 or 5.
7. In order to administer the Student Achievement Awards, COBIS will collect student names and citations for nominations. Before submitting the nomination, the staff member must ensure that they have obtained the correct consent from pupils/guardians when providing this information to COBIS. COBIS may ask for evidence of this consent. COBIS will also collect the nomination coordinator's name and email address as well as the head of school's name. Student names alongside the citations for their nominations and their school names may be displayed on the COBIS website, subject to consent being obtained via the online form. In line with the applicable Data Protection Laws, the data subject or legal guardian (if the data subject is under 18) may request the removal of their name at any time.
