Student Information

1. Arrive at GMMS Middle School 30-45 minutes before your scheduled performance time. Dress nicely.
2. Find your performance room first and then report to the gym to warm-up. This is the warm-up area. Orchestra student, you are to store your instrument cases in the gym.
3. Report to your performance room 10 minutes before your scheduled performance time.
4. 4. There are no copiers available at the site. **Copying music** is an infringement of the copyright law and **is illegal**. You must have two original pieces of music. One for you and one for your judge.
5. All Vocal and Piano performances must be memorized.
6. Give an original score of your music, with the measures numbered, to the judge before you play. If you are using music from the school, see your director for your music scores.
7. Band/Orchestra make sure to adjust your stand(s) and tune before you begin.
8. Wait for the judge's signal before you begin your performance.
9. Introduce your group by names of the participants and the title of your performance piece. For soloists, introduce your piano player.
10. Relax, take a deep breath, and enjoy your performance! Do the very best you can, smile and have fun.
11. Be attentive and courteous to your judge during the clinic and to others when they perform.
12. Be quiet in the halls and near the posting area.
