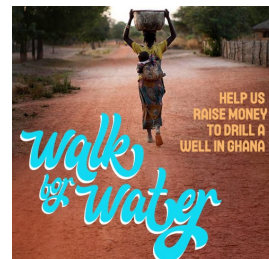

High School Book Drive

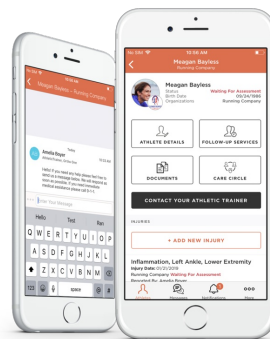
