## Health and Wellness Information:

Welcome and Introductions – Mrs. Hamilton welcomed everyone.

**Review of Previous Minutes**- Ms. Hamilton presented and asked everyone to review the minutes from the last SHAC meeting and asked for someone to approve and second the minutes. Ms. Yolanda Williams approved and Melissa Wray seconded the motion.

**COVID Update** – Mr. DeBeer gave a brief update on how many have tested positive on the campuses. They are continuing testing on campuses, drive thru testing and at the GWACHA campus daily. In the process of getting the vaccine from the state, they are not sure at this time when that will happen.

**CNS Update -** Mrs. Pennington discussed how the only challenge they are facing with the new Spring menu is what they can offer a variety to the students that have dietary needs. Some schools are doing classroom meals only. Curbside services have been cut down to 5 campuses, Alta Vista, Brook Ave, Bell's Hill, Dean Highland and Tennyson on Tuesday & Thursdays from 5:00-6:00.

**WACO ISD PD Update-** Chief Williams gave a brief update and stated that everything is going pretty smoothly. He stated that going virtual has made it a little more difficult on educating the students, what they do is more hands on but they are making it work.

**Discussion of Opioid Addiction Curriculum** – attendees were divided up into 3 group breakout sessions to discuss the 6 <u>TEA</u> recommended Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) National Registry of Evidence-Based Programs and Practices (NREPP). Each group was assigned two of the programs then returned and presented an overview as to the positive benefits for our students and then a short poll was taken after each presentation.

**Discussion of Future Agenda Items -** Continue looking at the programs presented and have someone from the curriculum department work with the committee on how each program will look in our schools and how we will implement them and the challenges that each will present.
