- II. Campus Needs Assessment 2019-2020
 - A. The process of conducting a Campus Needs Assessment was explained. Four areas identified in the CNS were reviewed.
- III. Formative Review of Campus Improvement Plan
 - A. Progress o Campus Improvement Activities were reviewed. Members were encouraged to review it and make suggestions the upcoming school year.
