

# THE KENNETH A. LOVE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

A scholarship fund has been established with the **Waco ISD Education Foundation** in memory of Kenneth A. Love, Waco High School Class of 2007, to aid graduates of Waco High in pursuing a post-secondary education. This scholarship is available for students with special needs who are served under an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) **OR** students who plan to pursue a degree in education or special education and/or a career in education or working with students with special needs. Applicants should be in need of financial support and are dedicated to attain the ultimate goal of a college degree.

Students will have an opportunity to receive a scholarship award of \$1,000.

To qualify for the Kenneth A. Love Scholarship Program for 2020 a student will be considered based on the following application criteria:

### APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

**Student Eligibility Criteria 1** – A student currently enrolled as a graduating high school senior at Waco High School.

**Student Eligibility Criteria 2** – Plan to enroll full-time without interruption for the entire 2020-2021 academic year at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school in the U.S.

**Student Eligibility Criteria 3** – Have a minimum grade point average of a 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent)

Student Eligibility Criteria 4 (2 options) -1) A student must have received special education services from at some point during the 2019-2020 school year through an IEP. A student does not need to have an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) for the entire year to qualify for the scholarship program. A student must be reported by a school district(s) in either fall or spring of the prior school year OR in final student record as a student receiving special education services by the end of the 2019-2020 school year.

**2)** A student must plan to pursue a degree in education or special education and/or pursue a career in education or working with students with special needs.

Students will be given the opportunity to express their commitment to post-secondary education through the completion of an application and selection process. Please complete the application, family information, and short answers on the following pages to help us best assess your financial needs.

We want to support you and your achievements by offering the funding that can make the difference; all you have to do is complete your application. Awards, if selected, will be determined by successful completion of application. Recipients will be announced at students' local high school. Information regarding the scholarship award payment will be provided to student at time of announcement.

Electronic applications are preferred and should be received via email by midnight May 15, 2020.
