Counselor's Corner

Attendance Matters

The school year is off to a great start, and we're already at the beginning of the 2nd 6 weeks! It is critical that your students are on time and in class each day. Waco High start time is **8:30**, and there are consequences for those who continually come in late, including lunch and after-school detention. If a student is more than 10 minutes late to any class, they are <u>absent from that class</u>, not just tardy.

This semester a student can have only **7 absences** to receive credit for a passing grade (spring semester it is 9). Please note that in high school, attendance is for each period and each period is its own set of absences. If your student has between 8-19 absences (in a period), they will not earn their credit and they will have to complete attendance recovery to earn that credit back (Saturday School). If your student goes over **20 absences**, the *credit is lost and cannot be earned*. This is state law! Even if your student has a 100% grade in a class, if they have over 19 absences, they will have to retake the course. Attendance is key to being a successful student and there is no remote school option at this time. If you have any questions about your student's attendance, please sign up for Parent

Portal @ https://www.wacoisd.org/Page/4222. There are instructions on the website for signing up. You can sign up to get alerts on your phone when your student is absent in a class as well as check your student's grades. We encourage all parents and students to sign up!

If your student is out for Covid, or quarantined for close contact, it is the responsibility of the student to contact their teachers to let them know. A student will have the same number of days that they are absent to recover their work upon their return.

COVID-19: Don't Forget Your Second Dose

The Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech vaccines are based on a two-dose regimen. People who receive the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine should get their second dose 21 days after the first ones. A follow-up Moderna vaccine should be administered 28 days after the initial dose. It's important to get both doses of these vaccines. The Johnson & Johnson vaccine is the only one that is a single-dose vaccine.

Why is a second shot needed?

Vaccines are intended to hardwire your immune system's memory so it can create a rapid, targeted and durable response by antibodies and T-cells to an invading virus. The second dose provides the immune system with advanced "training" to make better antibodies.




