Students have the opportunity to participate in Virtual Saturday school for previous semester/year attendance recovery. - 4) Click on Shop Graduation Products
- 5) You can either
  - A) Order a package with announcements and your cap and gown or
- B) Go to the bottom and click on **Green** Button **Shop Individuals Products**Select CAP, GOWN, AND TASSEL You MUST know your height and weight. Please be as accurate as possible.
- 6) Go to **Checkout** Enter your information.
- 7) Continue to **Shipping and Billing Information**
- 8) Enter your credit card information
- 9) Hit submit. You will receive a confirmation of your order.

#### NOTE: Your gown in NOT SHIPPING to your home.

You MUST make appointment with <u>ValerieM@texashj.com</u> to pick your items. Orders will NOT BE at school for pick up.




