What is Google Workspace for Education?

- Productivity suite that embraces the 4 C's of 21st Century Learning (Communication, Collaboration, Creativity, and Critical Thinking)
- Suite includes a word processor (Google Docs), a spreadsheet tool
 (Google Sheets), a presentation tool (Google Slides), and a
 learning management system (Google Classroom), Video Conferencing (Google Meets) and a
 Team Collaboration Space (Google Chat Spaces).





Google Meet vs. Zoom

Because we have upgraded to Google Workspace for Education, we now have advanced features for Google Meets that allows us to utilize that application for video conferencing vs. Zoom. Below are some of the features that Google Meets for Education Plus has for our teachers and students.

- Video conferences for up to 500 participants (Zoom has up to 100)
- Dedicated link and easy set up in Google Classroom (Zoom has to be set up)
- Teachers are automatically set up as the host (Zoom has to be set up)
- For meetings started within Classroom, only students and teachers in the class can join. (Zoom allows others to join)
- Sharing screens from Google Drive, Docs, Sheets, and Slides (Zoom has to be added)
- Record meetings directly to your Google Drive automatically (Zoom is added expense)
- Attendance tracking with automated reports (Zoom has this as well)
- Noise cancellation (Zoom as well)
- Automatically transcribe the meet (Zoom is added expense)

- Control presenting features and who can present (Zoom has this as well)
- Mute individuals or everyone at once (Zoom has this as well)
- Eject people from the meet (Zoom has this as well)
- Automatically block anonymous attendees (Zoom has to be set
- Video Lock or turn off video for all (Zoom does not have this
- Live captioning in a range of languages (Zoom is optional)
- Digital whiteboards (Zoom has this as well)
- Breakout Rooms (Zoom has this as well)
- Q and A & Polls (Zoom has this as well)
- Live Stream to people in wacoisd.org (Zoom does not have this)
- Live Stream to public outside of wacoisd.org (Zoom does not have this)

The best part of Google meets is that you already have an account with your Waco ISD Gmail account. It is ready to go!




