Waco ISD School Board Election Update

(WACO, TEXAS, February 17, 2023)- Ashley Stone has withdrawn her application for the At-Large, Place 7 seat on the Waco ISD School Board and has filed to run in the special election to fill the unexpired term in District 5 following the resignation of Trustee Emily Iazetti.

On May 6, 2023, voters will elect three members of the Waco Independent School District Board of Trustees. This includes positions representing Trustee District 3, Trustee District 5, and At-Large Place 7. Trustees representing District 3 and At-Large Place 7 will be elected to serve three-year terms ending in May 2026. The District 5 Trustee will be elected to serve the final two years of the current unexpired term for that position.

Today was the deadline to submit an application for a place on the ballot for Trustee District 3 and At-Large Place 7.

Jose Vidaña filed for re-election in District 3.

Peaches Henry filed for At-Large, Place 7 which is currently held by Angelo Ochoa, who has filed for reelection.

The deadline to submit an application for a place on the ballot in the special election for District 5 is Monday, March 6 at 5 p.m. Individuals can file applications between 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday through Friday on the 10th floor of the administration building.
