Carver Baptist Church is offering a mentor program for the upcoming school year, targeting 40 interested church members for on-campus mentorship. Plans are underway to schedule their presence during morning transitions for observation and planning throughout the summer.

PTA deliberated on supporting fundraising and campus events for the upcoming year, with a focus on gradually increasing family involvement. Testing protocols were discussed, emphasizing the prohibition of phones/devices during testing, and overall, the testing process was deemed successful.

Chaperone sign-ups for the 8th-grade prom were discussed, alongside teacher and parent feedback. It was clarified that parents must undergo a background check to access the campus during the prom, with a potential alternative venue being the aux gym. Prom requirements will

be reviewed, and graduation for 8th graders is scheduled for May 23rd at 9 AM, with each student allowed two guests and an anticipated hour-long ceremony. Two awards will be presented to students meeting the criteria for the "I AM G.W. Carver" distinction, with teacher input informing the selection process.

Preparations for 8th graders' departure at the end of the academic year were addressed, including communication via ParentSquare and distribution of t-shirts and tickets. Plans for testing make-ups and summer school were outlined. Summer school will be held at Cesar Chavez. Future plans will be discussed regarding summer school. Parents will be notified of their students' eligibility for promotion based on attendance and grades, with counselors tasked with compiling relevant lists. The meeting concluded at 6:34pm.
