The committee discussed ways the campus can further address student tardiness. The committee discussed ideas such as countdown clocks. The committee agreed in order for change to be implemented, everyone on the campus has to be involved. Teacher/Staff duties were discussed, this will be further discussed with Principal Lewis and will be reviewed in the next meeting. The committee discussed ways to involve our students,
