Facilitate family-to-family support

Increase family participation in decision making

- All PreK parents are invited and encouraged to attend our periodic campus "CDMC" meetings to learn about campus decisions and give a voice to PreK families that we serve.
- Families may choose to engage and communicate with their PreK students through the activities we post on the monthly calendar, Daily Vroom app, and CLI activities we have made available.

Equip families with tools to enhance and extend learning

- During campus Math or Literacy Nights, PreK students and families we be invited to participate in PreK-only activities, along with everything else.
- PreK Student assessments also come with parent pin numbers and a website to access free information and activities geared toward what each student needs.
- Daily Vroom and CLI activities may be printed for families whenever requested, English or Spanish.

Develop staff skills in evidence-based practices that support families in meeting their children's learning benchmarks

• PreK teachers and Aides participate in continuous Conscious Discipline training through the District.

Evaluate family engagement efforts and use evaluations for continuous improvement
