Waco ISD's Proposed use of ESSER II





What is the purpose of the CRRSA Act- ESSER funds?

The purpose of ESSER in general is to award subgrants to local educational agencies (LEAs) to address the impact that COVID-19 has had, and continues to have, on elementary and secondary schools.

How much funding is available to Texas LEAs?

\$5.5 billion is available to the state which will be awarded to eligible LEAs.

How is the agency planning to use the state's allocated discretionary funds?

ESSER II requires states to distribute discretionary funds to target evidence-based practices for learning acceleration, summer enrichment, mental health and other areas affected by the pandemic.

When will the grant funding end?

September 30, 2023 (with carryover)

- Surveys to parents, teachers, and staff

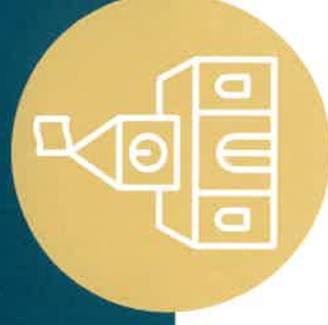
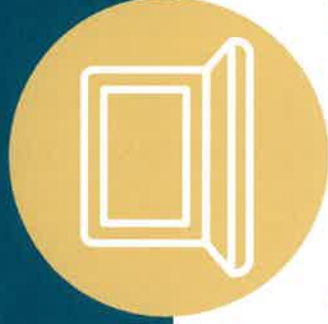
