#### 6. EDE report

Kelly reported on:

- In person learning is going well. 70% of ES students and 75% of secondary students are back on campus. The vast majority of teachers are back. Working with BVSD to provide Covid screening tests.
- Lots of celebrations as our seniors are receiving lots of scholarships and college acceptances.

- Assessment update
- Open enrollment numbers are updated and on our website. In general we are tracking in typical fashion.
- Gave Equity update. Discussions ensued on this subject.

## 7. EDO report

(written report was submitted)

Sam reported on:

- Lots of campus work was done over Spring Break (Thanks to John Wilcox).
- Board approved final bid for wall removal, team teaching project to be completed in July
- Allocated \$273,000 in ESSER II funds. BVSD recommends to spend those sooner rather than later.
- Commercial Credit Card Rebate of \$16,668 is earmarked for the innovation fund
- Transferred \$250K from the operating bank account at Chase to COLOTRUST
- Food services are feeding about 400 students a day
- Fundraising: Contributions amount to over \$205,000 for the annual fund the highest ever so far
- FDAC will start up again in the Fall with a new structure
- HR: Premiums are staying flat, health insurance and dental are increasing at about 2%
- Still working around fraudulent unemployment claims
- Participated in the State Charter Conference beginning of March
